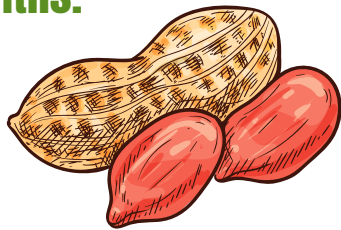
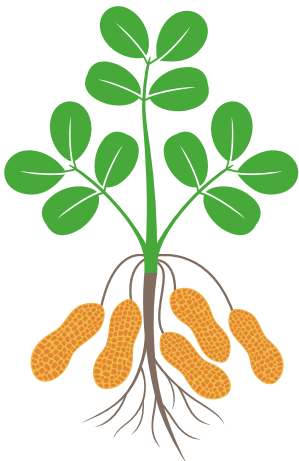


Peanut Fun Facts

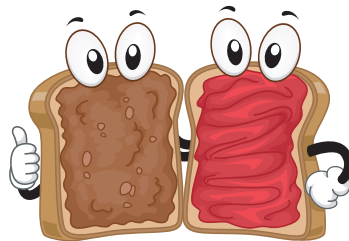
Peanuts are not actually nuts, but rather a legume that is related to beans and lentils.



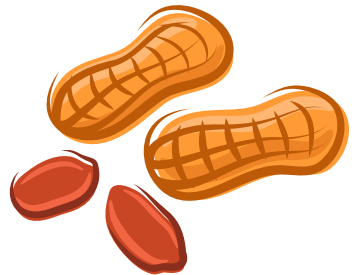
The edible seed starts growing above ground, but matures underground, so they are sometimes referred to as groundnuts!
